Getting a Library Card

To get a library card you will need a **valid, government-issued ID** with a **current address**. If the address is not current, additionally bring a piece of mail that is less than 60 days old with a current address.

Residents: No Fee.

Non-Residents: \$20.00 per year per household.

If you cannot afford the fee, you can apply for a **Non-Resident Waiver**, which would cover the cost of one year if approved.

Accessing Your Account

1. Go to www.rollapubliclibrary.org.
2. Hover on "FIND BOOKS & MORE" to get the drop down menu, then click on "MY ACCOUNT (NEW WINDOW)".
3. Enter your library card barcode number.
4. Enter your **PIN** number (the last four digits of your library card number).
5. You will now be able to see your checked out items, holds ready to be picked up, and change account settings.

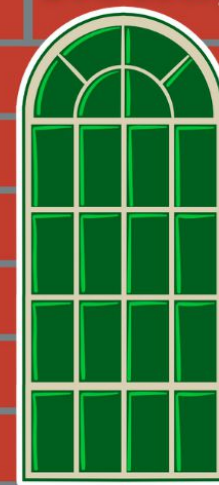

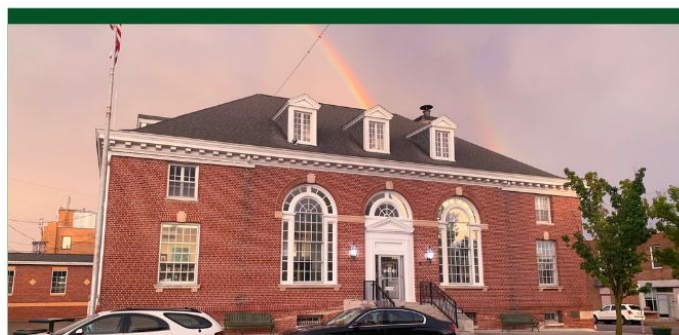
